

(RELATIVE TO ALL TURNBUCKLES)

To successfully fit your Shade sail you may need additional fixed linkages to bridge the gap between your fixing and chosen anchorage point. A correctly tensioned Shade Sail is the key to its longevity, so when choosing hardware it is important take the specifics of each product into consideration.








# **TURNBUCKLES**

Each end are threaded in opposite directions so that when you rotate the body of the turnbuckle one way tension will be increased, rotate the other way and tension will be released. A versatile fixing which allows for adjustments in precise increments, there is a large variety of turnbuckles that have fork - fork attachments.







### SINGLE END TURNBUCKLES

Unwind Turnbuckle, apply lubrication to the thread such as lanolin - this will stop the thread from seizing up.



Attach Shade Sail to fork connection at the fixed end of the Turnbuckle



Bridge any gap between Turnbuckle and anchorage points with non-adjustable fixings if required.



In turn tighten the barrel, a little at a time working around the Shade Sail until evenly tensioned all round.

Secure locking nuts against central barrel. Allow to settle in and re tension if necessary
